

TECH WEEK RULES

1. Attendance at tech rehearsals and all shows is mandatory.
2. Cast members are to listen to all adults backstage for everyone's safety. Adrenalin is running high and the kids are excited but any adult backstage is to be treated with respect. Failure to comply will result in not being cast in the future.
3. Rehearsals are closed. Family members are not allowed in the auditorium at any time with the exception of committee members with a purpose for being there.
4. Parent volunteers must leave all children not in the cast at home. Please be sure to make arrangements based on your volunteer schedule.
5. Absolutely no food or drink (except water and plain saltines/plain pretzels) will be permitted in the dressing rooms. Cast members are not allowed to purchase refreshments from the refreshment area. Childcare will take all other food and drinks away.
6. Cast members may not eat in costume at any time.
7. No gum.
8. Please be aware of what you eat the day of the show. Bright Bluecandy = a Bright Bluetongue!
9. Cast members must remain in the rooms to which they are assigned.
10. Cast members are to change from their costumes after each performance, BEFORE going into the lobby. No one is permitted to go out after a performance in costume unless instructed by the Director to do so.
11. Family and friends, former cast members, alumni, etc. are not permitted backstage. Don't invite them. This includes before the show, during intermission and after the show is over. Your child will come out to you.
12. IF we have an open dress rehearsal or if you are on a committee where you are in the theater during tech week, **we ask that you not post photos/videos to social media** and to be especially mindful of other children who might be in the background of your photos.
